What Will Be Covered:

- helping our dogs gauge distance and figure out striding prior to taking off for a jump
- distance and striding in between jumps
- solving jumping problems
- improving jumping style
- for participants who train/compete in obedience, specific problems related to obedience jumping will be addressed
- all jumps/exercises will start with low jump heights even for adult dogs

Who Should Attend:

- all dog & handler teams who need to jump in their chosen sport, agility or obedience
- young dogs learning how to jump
- older dogs, who need to jump as safely and efficiently as possible to prolong their active careers
- ideally, dogs should have a Wait/Start Line stay, but for those that do not, we can enlist helpers to restrain these dogs (these dogs should be wearing a harness)

What to Bring:

- food treats and/or toy rewards -- lots of them
- visible target plate (no sharing as a health precaution) We will have some available at the workshop

Fee:

- \$95 for working spots. Handlers with multiple dogs can choose which dog to use in each exercise
- \$50 for auditors
